Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 1400, Houston, Texas, 77056, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 8, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.**

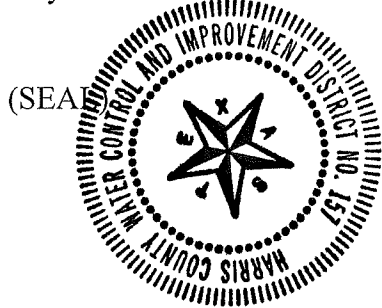
The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Approval of the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors held May 30, 2019, July 11, 2019, and July 23, 2019;
2. Public announcements, receive comments from the public (three speakers per topic, three minutes per speaker), review and respond to submissions from the District's website;
3. Status of District website, including revisions to content and related matters and update with OffCinco;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorization of payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Report on legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, and authorize foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claims;
6. Receive the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2019 tax rate, determine intended tax rate, and authorize:
 - a) the required notice that the Board will consider adoption of a tax rate; and
 - b) the means of providing such notice;
7. Bookkeeper's report, including: (i) financial and investment reports and the payment of invoices presented;
8. Operator's report, including:
 - a) Monthly report;
 - b) Repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - c) Appeals of District charges; and
 - d) Status of make-up well permit renewals;
9. Engineer's report, including:
 - a) Authorize the design, advertisement for bids and award of construction contracts

or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District;

- 1) Bridgeland SWG-2012-00328 Mitigation Tract Forested Plantings;
 - b) Construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders, including:
 - 1) Excavation and Spoil Disposal for Wetland Mitigation Phase I – Contractor: Sonora Construction, Inc.;
 - 2) Mitigation Tract Herbaceous Planting – Contractor: Apache Ecological Services, Inc.; and
 - 3) Josey Lake Park – Phase I & II Landscape – Contractor: D.L. Meacham, LP;
 - c) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and conveyance of sites and/or easements by the District;
 - d) General landscaping improvements (i.e., park benches, tree installation, and bridge structure at Cypress Creek) within the District, and approval of pay estimates and/or change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, for same as and if necessary;
 - e) Review of Capital Improvement Plan, and authorize any necessary action in connection therewith; and
 - f) General engineering matters, including review of District's contract for engineering services with BGE, Inc.;
10. Financial Advisor's Report, including status of preparation of Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") for Approval of Project and Bonds, relative to the proposed issuance of the District's Series 2019 Bonds for park and recreational facilities and filing of same with the TCEQ;
 11. Storm water pollution prevention and storm water quality management report by Delta West Environmental;
 12. Mowing and maintenance reports by Southern Green Lawns, LLC, and Spencer Outdoor, LLC, approval of proposals, pay estimates and/or change orders in connection therewith, including discussion regarding status of bidding of maintenance packages for Bridgeland community;
 13. Detention/amenity pond aquatic and wildlife management, including status of wildlife management and fish management;
 14. Developer's report;

15. Attorney's report;
16. Status of annexation into and exclusion of certain land from the boundaries of the District, including calling of an exclusion hearing in connection therewith;
17. Scheduling of future meetings; and
18. Any other business.
